Tibet's fall

As to the question why for instance the great and famous Tibetan leaders did not use their superior spiritual powers to save their country from the Chinese invasion - there can only be said, that spiritual powers used for physical, "worldly" purposes in that way would become equal to physical powers (just a sort of super-weapon), and there would be no difference. Therefore also Jesus Christ did not use his super-powers in order to save himself from the cross.

For all the higher, greater Personages have shown, that for them there is no distinction of nations, creed, castes, sex, etc. for it is established in their nature. All are alike to them and so they leave the world's children to their rough play, - just watching and loving them

Therefore, if a nation gets weak, it will get destroyed, or - by that lesson of the fight, that is, get stronger. This has anyhow repeated itself many, many times already in this world, and yet the world is going on. But spiritual force should not be used for this fighting.

On the contrary; if somewhere the spiritual powers are not established and stabilized enough in the people they will be overthrown also in future. And this, though tragical, will be going on, until the spiritual powers have gained enough ground to overcome all materialism.
